in the County of Surrey the sume of One Shilling to be paid
within One month after my decease. Item my will is that
all my moneys and all manner of personall Estate
whatsoever and wheresoever and ffreehold Land
whatsoever and wheresoever. I give and bequeath to
my neice Elizabeth Boxall daughter of my Brother John
Boxall late of Guildford in the County of Surrey aforesaid.
Also making her Sole Executrix of this my last will and
testament under the trust and care of Elizabeth Boxall

her mother in Law and George Burle of Purforde each jointly
Trustees of this my Last will and testament acknowledging this
and none other to be my last will and testament In witness
whereof I have sett my hand and seale the day and yeare
above written – Tho: Boxall – Signed Sealed Published and
declared to be the Last will and testament of Thomas Boxall
in the presence of us – John Mills – the marke of Robert Knite –
the mark of Ann Harington.
